Rescue Vehicle in Action

- Captain Tony Pine gave an update about how the Rescue Vehicle aided the PD recently.
 - Delafield shooting of two police officers: The Rescue Vehicle was used to provide protection for the NBPD while they hunted down the suspect, who had already proven that he was willing to shoot police officers.
 - Mayfair Mall shooting: The Rescue Vehicle was used to provide protection for the NBPD while they searched for the suspects.
 - New Berlin High Speed Chase: The Rescue Vehicle was used to provide protection for the NBPD as they tracked and apprehended the suspects.
 - Armed Suicide Suspect: The Rescue Vehicle was used to provide protection for the NBPD as they negotiated with an armed suicide suspect.
