### Scam Alert

- The NBPd has requested that we alert our membership of the latest scam so that you can be watchful for this and not fall victim to it.
  - People are receiving calls from Publisher's Clearing House telling them that they have won money, but have to pay 1% to have it delivered. The phone number is not valid or traceable. **THIS IS A SCAM.** Real companies will never ask you to pay a percentage to receive or release your winnings. Never give out your birth date, social security number or bank account number to people who call you on the phone. Be especially suspicious of anyone asking for payment or financial assistance with gift cards.
  - You do not need to call the police department if you receive one of these calls. **ONLY** call if you have been a victim of this scam. Use the non-emergency number: 262-782-6640.
