Special Fundraising Opportunity – NBPCAAA Matching Grant

Multijurisdictional Rescue Vehicle

New Berlin Citizens,

The Suburban Critical Incident Team (SCIT) is a multijurisdictional law enforcement tactical team composed of officers and EMS personnel from Brookfield, Chenequa, Delafield, Elm Grove, Hartland, Mukwonago, Muskego, New Berlin and Pewaukee that serves 140,000 citizens.

SCIT is looking for your help so that they can purchase a multi-purpose rescue vehicle to expand their abilities when responding to critical emergencies that require evacuation, rescue, and versatility during critical incidents. Examples would be:

- Safely transport officers, EMTs and K9s to and from high-risk incidents.
- Rescue, evacuate and protect citizens from dangerous critical incidents.
- Conduct search and rescue missions during natural disasters.
- Achieve modern standards for critical incident resolution.
- Use as a position of safety when targeted by armed suspects.

The vehicle will be housed at the New Berlin Police/Fire building.

The NBPCAAA is offering a Matching Grant, up to a total of \$10,000 to help New Berlin achieve their portion of the vehicle cost. This means that for every dollar that you donate, the NBPCAAA will match your donation. The total fundraising goal for all of the communities is \$300,000.
